Following all rules and

regulations regarding the use, storage and handing of chemicals on the farm is extremely important.



Knowing the safety risks of all farm machinery such as vehicles, augers and post hole diggers is essential prior to their operation.



Locating underground cables before digging and being aware of overhead powerlines when operating machinery can save lives.



Designing workshops

with consideration of noise, ventilation, lighting, storage and layout can considerably minimise safety risks.
